## Food truck serves buka puasa meals to personnel at Hang Tuah fire station

WHILE most people are planning their celebrations with family this festive season, security personnel have to be on duty.

This year, Bank Simpanan Nasional (BSN), in collaboration with mStar, *The Star's* Malay-language portal, has rolled out its #kongsinikmat campaign to share the blessings of Ramadan with security personnel on duty through the #kongsinikmat food truck.

There are four stops, the first being the Jalan Hang Tuah fire station where 400 packs of Nasi Ayam Bakar and beverages were distributed to personnel.

Nordin also urged the public to be extra careful during festive periods.

"Most incidents are caused by carelessness and can be avoided," he said, adding that 70% of household fires were from electrical sources.
